The urinary bladder is located in the pelvic cavity posterior to the pubic symphysis. its function is to store urine before micturition. storage. Table 26. and metanephros. organs. increased frequency of urination. sweat glands help eliminate excess heat. and renal calculi. Besides the kidneys. and processes temporarily confine wastes. and the gastrointestinal tract eliminates solid wastes.

On leaving the urinary bladder, urine passes through the urethra, which conducts the urine to the exterior. • The urinary bladder and the urethra are responsible for the elimination of urine, a process called urination or micturition. When dilute urine is being formed, the osmolarity of the fluid in the tubular lumen increases as it flows down the descending limb of the loop of Henle, decreases as it flows up the ascending limb, and continues to decrease as it flows through the rest of the nephron and collecting duct.
